1. We, the Muslim refugees of Neustadt an der Weinstraße, strongly disagree with any sort of violence and Islamistic terror.
2. Nobody has got the right to call anyone a „nonbeliever“ and kill him.
3. There is peace in Europe, because the different countries and religions respect each other.
4. If the Europeans were not so tolerant, many of us would be dead now or live in war-torn countries.
5. We want to live in peace and accept and welcome other ways of thinking and living.
6. We hope that all people will live peacefully together, no matter whether they belong to different Muslim, Christian or any other religion or prefer not to be religious at all.
7. We are peaceful Muslims and we are very grateful for the very friendly reception in Germany and especially here in Neustadt.
8. We respect the German constitution.
9. A peaceful cohabitation is of great importance to us and we will actively help to prevent any radicalisation or attempts at spreading hate and disdain among us.
